HUNTERDON LAND TRUST FARMERS' MARKET CELEBRATES HIKING ON AUGUST 26

Flemington, NJ — The Hunterdon Land Trust's Farmers' Market at the Historic Dvoor Farm is highlighting hiking on Sunday, August 26, 9 am to 1 pm. "We're very lucky to live in a county with so many parks and so much preserved land" said Catherine Suttle, the manager of the Farmers' Market. "The variety of hikes, from an easy stroll to a challenging work out, and the different types of terrain you can find here in Hunterdon are a real gift."

The Hunterdon Land Trust Farmers' Market at the Historic Dvoor Farm (111 Mine Street, Flemington) is open every Sunday from 9 am to 1 pm through November 18. The land trust welcomes volunteers or farmers' interested in participating in the market.
